

## Cowan's Flag Day Ceremony - June 14

The Town of Cowan will celebrate the history, heritage, and unity of "Old Glory" on Wednesday, June 14th, at 5 p.m. in front of the log cabin court house. (Across the track from Cowan Railroad Museum).

On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress adopted the Flag of the United States with 13 stripes of red and blue, and a union of stars on a blue field.

The history of the flag also brings the legendary story of Betsy Ross who sewed the first version according to her family memoirs.

## Support the Repair of the Log Cabin Court House in Franklin County

The historic Cowan Depot, home of Cowan Railroad Museum, is the town's most visible and widely-recognized landmark. However, a lesser known and equally important landmark is beautifully situated in the downtown railroad park as well.

The Log Cabin Court House is a replica of the original home of Major William Russell, one of the area's prominent pioneer settlers. A friend of Tennessee's famous Davy Crockett, Russell served as the first Judge Magistrate in

Franklin County. The humble log cabin and the surrounding property were host to court trials, small court matters, court musters, and even county-wide elections before the county seat was formally established in Winchester.

In preparation for our nation's Bicentennial Celebration in 1976, a group of Cowan residents constructed a replica of the Russell home to serve as a festival exhibit. The log cabin replica has since welcomed many thousands of admirers.

Now that the replica has been in place for nearly five decades, the time has come to recondition and strengthen the structure. Cowan Commercial Club, a local civic organization, is leading a campaign to raise funds and to recruit some skilled hands to bring the cabin back to a state of good repair.
